

**ORDINANCE #2007-010:**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VANCEBORO IN THE COUNTY OF CRAVEN, STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA, TO ADOPT NO PARKING AREAS ON US HIGHWAY 43 (MAIN STREET) and NEW STREET, WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS**

**THAT WHEREAS**, the Vanceboro Board of Alderman has determined that it is in the Health, Safety, and Welfare interests of both the guests and of the citizens of Vanceboro to prohibit parking at these locations;

**WHEREAS**, the Vanceboro Board of Alderman deems it necessary to prohibit parking, on portions of US Highway 43 (Main Street) and on a portion of New Street to prevent vehicles and tractor trailers from being parked on either side of the road obstructing view of vehicles leaving businesses;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VANCEBORO BOARD OF ALDERMAN** that:

Section 1. There shall be No Parking as follows:


1. on the East side of US Highway 43 (Main Street) starting at a point 435' South of Stewart Avenue and ending 300' from said point;
2. on the West side of US Highway 43 (Main Street) starting at the South corner of US Highway 43 (Main Street) and New Street, and ending 145' from said point; and
3. on the North side of New Street starting at the North corner of US Highway 43 (Main Street) and New Street, and ending 255' from said point.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$25.00 to the Town Clerk within 15 days after receiving a citation for violation.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
