- I. Call to order by Mayor Chad Braxton.
- II. Roll call Those Present: Mayor Chad Braxton, Alderman David Dunn, Alderman Billy Whitford, Alderman Todd McMillen and Alderman Dennis Smith. Those Absent: Alderman Earl Wright.
- III. Invocation by Alderman Billy Whitford.
- IV. Pledge of Allegiance.
- V. Approval of minutes from last meeting. Alderman Dunn made a motion to approve minutes as read. Motion was seconded by Alderman Whitford and carried. Vote 4-0.
- VI. Approval of Cash Receipts and Disbursements. Alderman Smith made a motion to pay bills. Motion was seconded by Alderman Whitford and carried. Vote 4-0.
