Accepted Materials



- ✓ Cooking oil
- ✓ Drain openers
- ✓ Batteries
- ✓ Paint: Latex* and oil based; paint thinners
- ✓ Automotive fluids: gasoline, used motor oil, anti-freeze
- ✓ Pesticides: Lawn, garden, and farm pesticides and fertilizer

10 gallons max per vehicle.

*Dried latex paint may be disposed of via normal waste collection

Non-Accepted Materials

- ⊗ Gas cylinders
- ⊗ Commercial waste
- ⊗ Infectious, biological, or radioactive wastes
- ⊗ Explosives
- ⊗ Ammunition
